# About the Range

The Cheyenne Mountain Shooting Complex is a joint project between the U.S. Army, El Paso County, the El Paso County Sheriff, Colorado Parks and Wildlife and the U.S. Forest Service. The CMSC also received a significant contribution from The National Rifle Association (NRA).

The 400 acre site sits on Army land near Interstate 25 just off mile marker 132. The entrance is located just outside Fort Carson's Gate 20 security perimeter.

Customers do not require Fort Carson access to use the Cheyenne Mountain Shooting Complex.

The Range Complex is a three phase project. Phase one is now complete and includes 120 shooting positions across seven ranges.

The second phase of the project will include the construction of five skeet & trap ranges and a club house. The club house will include a retail store, classrooms and offices.

Completion of the project will occur during third phase with the addition of a restaurant.

Range 1 is designated as a Law Enforcement Range and is available to the public only on weekends. It allows for firing points from 25 to 300 yards on paper and out to 1000 yards on steel.

Ranges 2 and 3 are designated specifically for rifles. It allows for firing points between 25 to 300 yards on paper and 600 yards on steel.

Range 4 is a combination rifle & pistol range. It allows for firing points from 12 to 100 yards on paper and out to 400 on steel.

Ranges 5 and 6 are designed specifically for pistols. It allows for firing points from 10 to 50 yards on paper and out to 75 on steel for handguns only.
