Operational and functional tasks include providing web audio visual content within the web environments, coordinate production, and maintain web visual requirements in IT graphics and imaging.

Roles and Responsibilities

- Install, configure, operate, and administer common user web and portal servers.
- Provide user support and troubleshooting for all approved applications, logon availability for new users and support personnel.
- Apply web page design principles and methods used by SharePoint Portal Server 2003/2007, Solaris Sun One Web Server, and Microsoft IIS; graphics markup languages; multimedia principles, methods, and tools; programming languages; Internet server maintenance techniques; performance monitoring methods; file formats; and browser technical requirements sufficient to ensure that new web applications are consistent with relevant design and formatting standards; core development tools of this industry such as Dreamweaver, Fireworks and Photoshop or equivalent software tools; technologies and solutions used for accomplishing specific client side and server side tasks.
- Monitor dynamic interfaces in both JSP and .NET environments using a variety of tools, scripts and databases.
