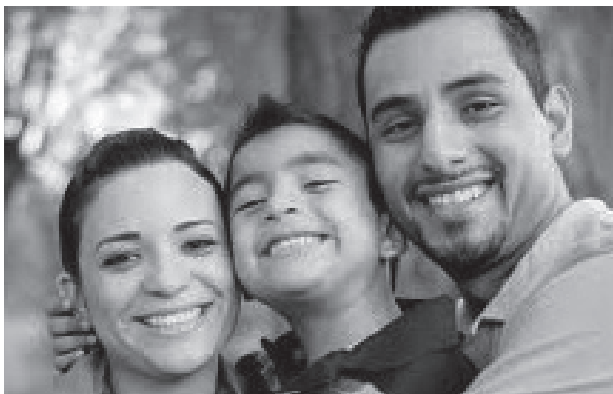


ARMY COMMUNITY SERVICE (ACS)

EXCEPTIONAL FAMILY MEMBER PROGRAM



An Exceptional Family Member (EFM) is a Family member, child or adult, with any physical, emotional, developmental or intellectual disorder that requires special treatment, therapy, education, training or counseling. Enrollment into the EFMP is required for Soldiers with Family members who meet the enrollment criteria. Enrollment information is confidential, and used solely for assignment purposes, however, in some cases may be required to qualify for supplemental care or services.

The EFMP assists military personnel agencies in making assignments for the Soldier, while considering the documented medical and/or educational needs of the Soldier's enrolled Family member. The program provides a multi-agency approach for community support, housing, medical, educational and personnel services to Families with special health and/or educational needs or concerns.

All Soldiers are eligible for worldwide tours, unaccompanied tours, and deployments, regardless of EFMP status. Careful planning is a must to ensure adequate care of EFMs while a Soldier is performing required military duties.
