Welcome

Welcome to the user guide for the Army's Family Readiness Group (FRG) Mobile web system. This guide will give you an introduction to the mobile environment for the FRG and illustrate the key features of the mobile site.

Site Layout

FRG Mobile is arranged to suit the smaller format of mobile devices with important features displayed prominently.



	FRG Mobile Feature	Description
1.	Login button	Use to log in to the site. Once logged in, this will become a Logout button.
2.	Support Menu	Quick links to FAQ , Contact Us , and (when not logged in) a link to password help.
3.	Content	The content feature displays the outlets built into the current screen.



Navigation

To navigate through website, use your finger to scroll up and down and to select desired links.

Scrolling

1. To scroll down when on a page place your finger in the middle of the screen and flick upward in one motion. The page will pan down to reveal the lower section of the page.

2. To scroll up place your finger in the middle of the screen and flick downward. The page will pan up to reveal the upper section of the page in one motion.

3. To select a link, simply tap it with your finger.



Logging In

To log into the mobile site:

- 1. Click the **Login** button at the top of the screen. A security warning will appear with the username and password fields displayed at the bottom of the screen.
- 2. Enter your username and password and press the **Login** button.
- 3. The **Choose Your Unit Site** page appears.



- 4. Choose which site you'd like to access by selecting the radio button next to that site and tap the **Go** button. Select the **Remember my selection and don't ask again** checkbox to log in without being prompted with this page in the future.
- 5. By selecting the Army FRG Home page, the user will be taken to the Army FRG's page.

Accessing Your Unit Site

To access your Unit site:

- 1. Tap the **Switch Unit Site** button will take the user to the **Choose Your Unit Site** page, where the user can then select which site to access.
- 2. Selecting the Unit site and tapping the **Go** button will take the user to the Unit site.



Unit Site

The Unit site will be displayed in a similar fashion as the FRG home page with a top bar including the FRG logo and a **Log Out** button.



	FRG Mobile Feature	Description
1.	Log Out button	Use to log out of the site. Once logged out, the user will be returned to the FRG home page and this button will become a Login button.
2.	Unit site banner	Here, the Unit site banner will appear, indicating which site the user is currently on.
3.	Invite Family Members link	The Invite Family Members button gives users a quick way to invite Family Members to a Unit site. This is only available to users that are logged in as Sponsors (Family Members will not have access to this button).
4.	Switch Unit Site button	The Switch Unit Site button takes the user to the Choose Your Unit Site page.
5.	Unit site wall	The Unit site wall is a list of the most recently added and/or updated items.
