The Troops to Teachers Program

Troops to Teachers (TTT) is a military career transition program that helps eligible members of the armed forces begin new careers as K-12 public school teachers. Skills acquired in the military like leadership, initiative, discipline, integrity, and the ability to thrive in an ever-changing environment are a natural fit for the classroom.

The Program Provides:

Counseling and Referral Assistance - guidance on state teacher certification and education requirements leading to employment opportunities

Financial Assistance - stipend of up to \$5,000 to obtain education, certification or licensing; and/or a bonus of up to \$10,000 to teach in qualifying schools (combination of stipend and bonus may not exceed \$10,000)

Teaching is an option for every service member looking for a rewarding career after the military.
