Pipe Freeze Warning

With winter weather here, temperatures can drop below freezing suddenly, as is anticipated the next several days. Significant facility damage is possible if appropriate actions are not taken. Facility managers, building occupants and unit leadership are asked to ensure the following:

- Ensure all windows and exterior doors are closed.
- Keep all heating systems on even in unoccupied buildings (do not turn off any units). Set any self-adjustable thermostats to at least 55 degrees (barracks set to 60 degrees).
- Building occupants can call 526-5345, the Directorate of Public Works (DPW) operations and maintenance contractor 24/7 service order desk, if their buildings are not heating properly.
- If there are any busted or leaking pipes noticed, call in a service order immediately to the DPW operations and maintenance contractor at 526-5345.





Army Community Service – Exceptional Family Member Program



The Exceptional Family Member Program (EFMP) - What is it?

The EFMP is a Department of the Army program designed to assist military personnel agencies in making assignments for the Soldier, accompanied by Family members as often as possible, based on the documented medical and special education needs of the Soldier's Exceptional Family Member (EFM). When possible, Soldiers are assigned to duty locations where the medical and special education needs of their EFM can be met. It is important to understand that this is dependent upon a valid personnel requirement for the Soldier's grade, specialty, and eligibility for the tour. All Soldiers are still eligible for worldwide and unaccompanied assignments.

Volunteer attorneys will answer questions, help fill out forms, and explain the process and procedure for civil legal issues, including family law, civil litigation, property law, probate law, collections, appeals, landlord-tenant law, veteran's benefits, and civil protection orders.

The volunteer attorneys do not represent you just because they help you at this clinic. This clinic is information only, and is no substitute for legal representation. You have the right to retain an attorney of your choice at any time, and are advised to do so.

If possible, patrons are encouraged to have their desktop, laptop, or tablet available during the call.
