

FAQ:

Q: Is the Spring Market free?

A: Entry to Iron Horse Park, parking, and the ACS carnival booths are free. A wristband must be purchased per person for the bounce houses. Food and beverage will be available for purchase. ATMs will not be on-site, be sure to bring cash if needed. Cards are accepted for purchase of food and beverages, and activity wristbands. Cash is encouraged if you plan to shop around at the flea market, many vendors may not take a card. There is a fee to become a vendor, please see below.

Q: Where do I park for the Spring Flea Market?

A: Several parking lots are within walking distance of the event site. Main parking will be off of Sheridan Ave. Additional parking will be available on the east side of Iron Horse Park, off of Wetzel Ave. Parking is free and is first-come-first-served. Please do not park at the Commissary or PX.

Q: Is the Spring Flea Market a rain or shine event?

A: Yes; please follow our [Facebook Page](#) for the latest updates on the event. By attending this event, you are assuming the risk of injury by inclement weather. The only time the event will be canceled will be due to an installation-wide post closure.

Q: Can I buy individual tickets for activities or do I have to buy the wristband?

A: You must buy the wristband for any child 4+. Children 3 & under are free. The wristband provides all-day unlimited access to bounce houses.

Q: Can I purchase wristbands early?

A: Yes, you can purchase wristbands at the Outdoor Recreation Complex starting 01 April. All sales are final, no refunds will be issued. Wristbands will be available for purchase at the event site, starting at 10am. Please expect long lines. We highly encourage pre-purchasing wristbands, to reduce wait times at the event.

Q: Can I bring my dog?

A: All pets are prohibited at the Spring Flea Market. ADA service animals are allowed.

Q: Is there a Lost and Found? Is there a First Aid station? Lost Child?

A: Yes, the Spring Flea Market Lost & Found, First Aid, and Lost Child stations are located at the main stage.

Q: Is the event open to the public?

Q: Do I need to be a DoD ID card holder to be a vendor?

A: Yes, all vendors must have an adult (18+) at the booth.
