New IDES / WTB Soldiers SFAC Orientation

Integrated Disability Evaluation System (IDES) & Warrior Transition (WTB) Soldiers Transition Process

Your transition through the IDES process is important to the Army Community Service Soldier & Family Assistance Center (SFAC). Please review the following information to ensure your transition is successful.

Drientation Brief Every Tuesday • 12:45-2 p.m.

Attending this brief as soon as possible maximizes participation in all programs and services. This brief is mandatory for WTB and highly encouraged for IDES.

Transition Briefing Every Tuesday or Thursday • 9:45-11 a.m.

Once you know your Army Disability Rating or after signing your final DA Form 199, Soldiers MUST attend the "Transition Briefing".

3 Leave Calculation Appointment

By appointment only—scheduled by SFAC staff after attending Transition Briefing Appointment scheduled after DA Form 199 is reviewed AND final approval for discharge from Physical Disability Agency (PDA) is made. —waiting time 24 hours to 6 weeks after signing Form 199.

Final-Out Medical Separations Appointment

Scheduled by SFAC Staff during Leave Calculation Appointment Within 24-72 hours of the leave calculation appointment, the Soldier will receive their orders from the Fort Carson Transitions Center.
