

Tuition Assistance (TA)

- TA can be used for up to 75% of Tuition Cost, but may not exceed:
- \$250.00 per Semester Hour
- \$166.00 per Quarter Hour
- \$4500.00 per Fiscal Year

Restrictions

TA is only available for one course per session or semester, and will only be approved for one course at any given time.

Course start dates cannot overlap with courses that are being attended, that haven't been completed.

Members may use TA in conjunction with Pell Grants, but may not be used in conjunction with active or reserve military TA and/or with Department of Veterans Affairs educational benefits, or with any federally insured student loan

Food Service Worker Position Description:

The primary purpose is: to serve food and beverages informally, prepare service areas, prepare simple foods, and perform related tasks.

Major Duties

1. Sets up cafeteria lines, food service counters, steam tables, dining room tables, and side service stands.
2. Prepares fruits and vegetables for cooking and serving.
3. Clears, breaks down, and cleans assigned area.
4. Serves and apportions a variety of meats, vegetables, desserts, etc.
5. Utilizes safety and sanitation practices, rules, regulations, and procedures.

Key Requirements

- U.S. Citizenship Required
- Must be registered for Selective Service, see Legal & Regulatory Guidance
- This position is subject to provisions of the DoD Priority Placement Program
