The National Youth of the Year program is a comprehensive youth leadership development program organized by the Boys and Girls Club of America, with which Fort Carson Youth Center is partnered. Youth of the Year recognizes young people for their outstanding leadership, service, academic excellence, and dedication to health and wellbeing. Thousands of teens participate in local, state and regional events, where winners are eligible for scholarships and other prizes. Five regional winners and one national military youth winner advance to the National Youth of the Year Celebration, where one outstanding teen is named Boys & Girls Clubs of America's national teen spokesperson.

Megan Martinez joined the Fort Carson CYS family in October and has since kickstarted the initiative to encourage participation in this prestigious event, which is open to all Youth Center program participants from grades 9-12. She has also initiated a "Youth of the Month" and "Staff of the Month" awards for the Youth Center, to encourage all participants to thrive even if they aren't yet eligible for Youth of the Year.

"We really want to get the younger youth involved, and since they can't participate in Youth of the Year, we have Youth of the Month to recognize them," Martinez stated, "to acknowledge the good things that they're doing and help set them up to be good community members."

The staff votes on the Youth of the Month, and the youth in turn vote for their Staff of the Month, as an opportunity to feel that their voices are also heard and empowered. Martinez believed having a youth recognition program is very important. "If you recognize the youth for the positive things they're doing, it makes them feel good; it boosts their self esteem, their self confidence."

Recruitment and the application process for Youth of the Year begins in the fall at the start of the school year, with a nomination around January to prepare for the state competition at the end of the school year. Martinez describes the process as "very intense. You have to be able to do public speaking, you'll write essays, you'll do a resume, volunteer hours. So there's a lot that goes into it." The Youth Center staff aids any interested teens in filling out their applications and guiding them through the necessary tasks and criteria, then conducts an interview process with volunteers from the community.

The last Youth of the Month, Precious Mae Llena, also happens to be Youth Center's nominee for Youth of the Year. Precious was surprised to realize she had been chosen. "I never thought of myself to be much of a speaker," she admitted. "I get nervous and trip over my words." But her actions speak much louder than words, demonstrating kindness and leadership through her role in the Youth Center's Keystone Club. She is lauded by the Youth Center staff as "outstanding, always willing to step up and help."

Precious also spends time volunteering for the Red Cross. As a first-generation American from a family of immigrants, Precious places great importance on supporting her family and her community, as well as those in need. "I would like to explore more about medical care, especially since I wanted to work within humanitarian aid," Precious explained. "My family has always given back to the family, the community, and the street children in the Philippines. I wish to contribute to something like that, but also potentially doing it for other parts of the world where they really need it."

When asked what made her decide to apply for Youth of the Year, Precious said she realized it was a good opportunity to step out of her comfort zone, speak out for what she believes in, and potentially inspire others to do the same. "Real change is a slow process and it starts within us and locally," she added. "Shout out to friends, family, and my best friend Koby Bolton for supporting me."

In the four essays she wrote for her Youth of the Year submission, Precious advocates learning to empathize, treating others with respect and care, and working together to overcome challenges. "Everyone has their own struggles, and some don't have the confidence or opportunity to speak up. That's when I realized that I want to be an advocate for those who don't have a voice," she states. "I believe we all have a responsibility to support one another. If we don't lift each other up, who will?"

SSG CALEB SECHLER

A Tribute in Sweat and Strength: SSG Sechler Leads the Charge in the 20th Anniversary Murph Challenge

The Murph Challenge is an annual fundraiser of the LT. Michael P. Murphy Memorial Scholarship Foundation, held around Memorial Day in honor of LT. Michael P. Murphy, a United States Navy SEAL and Medal of Honor recipient who died in combat in 2005 while protecting his men.

LT. Murphy was the officer-in-charge of a four-man SEAL element in support of Operation Red Wings in Asadabad, Afghanistan. Despite suffering grave gunshot wounds during an intense firefight, Murphy risked his own life to save the lives of his teammates, moving through extreme open terrain and knowingly exposing himself to increased enemy gunfire to transmit a call to headquarters for assistance. He completed the call despite being shot in the back, returned to his cover position with his men, and continued firing back at the enemy while severely wounded. Due to Murphy's heroic efforts, one member of his team was able to escape to safety.

LT. Murphy's sacrifice and memory, as well as that of his men lost in Operation Red Wings, is honored through this annual challenge, which consists of a beginning 1 mile run, 100 pullups, 200 push-ups, 300 squats, and ends with an second 1 mile run, all completed while wearing body armor or a 20 lb weight vest. Participants are pushed to their limits and encouraged to keep pushing through the pain and exhaustion, a powerful reminder of the sacrifices made by our military and a testament to the strength and resilience of the human spirit.

The Murph Challenge 2025 marks the 20th year anniversary of Operation Red Wings. This year's winner here at Fort Carson is SSG Caleb Sechler. This was his second time participating in the Murph Challenge, first time winning. Sechler admitted he does not regularly participate in other workout competitions, explaining that he mainly trains for his own sake, "to keep my head straight." He was originally made aware of the The Murph Challenge through flyers and advertisements catching his eye while working out.

"I knew it was one of the bigger work outs people participated in, and all the movements were simple enough," he explained. "I figured it would be a good challenge."

When Sechler crossed the final finish line he was surprised how smoothly the challenge went, shocked to find he was the winner, and quite happy with the time he achieved. He had just returned from a training school out of state a week prior, and didn't feel as if he had reacclimated yet to the altitude and only had a few other workouts before attempting the challenge.

He felt the easiest part had been the initial run, treating it like a quick warm-up while he was not too tired. The most difficult part for Sechler was staying at a consistent pace throughout the challenge, reminding himself to not pause too long and maintaining the determination to finish, telling himself "I still have a lot on my plate to complete."

Sechler closed his remarks by encouraging participation in future challenges: "Anybody should give it a shot: half Murph, full Murph, give it a shot, push yourself to something better."






The Hub

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

Advance School Enrollment for Military Dependents

Inbound active-duty military members with orders to a Department of Defense installation in Colorado can utilize specific legislation to enroll their dependents in school remotely.

Key Highlights:

Remote Enrollment: Families can enroll electronically without appearing in person.

Residency Requirements: Orders cannot be used to establish residency, but enrollment may use the School Liaison Office address.

Required Documentation: Enrollment forms, proof of residency, and disciplinary records (due within 10 days of attendance).

Enrollment Opportunities: Access to specific schools, programs, courses, charter school enrollment, and open enrollment.

Additional Benefits: Guaranteed matriculation within the school or district.

Priority enrollment for younger siblings in future school years.
