# War Dog Memorial 5k FAQ:

## Q: How much does the War Dog Memorial 5k cost?

**A:** Registration is \$20. This includes a custom t-shirt and sticker. This fee is for persons over the age of 3. Anyone aged 3 and under can run for free with their adult participant. People that want to attend, but not run, can attend for free and purchase food and beverages or cheer on the runners.

### Q: Where do I register?

A: Ivy Fitness Center, during their normal operating hours, or you can register the same day (21 May).

# Q: How long is the run?

**A:** It is a 5k, which is 3.1 miles. Participants are welcome to walk or run. There is also a 1 mile option! Choose either distance.

## Q: Where do I park for the War Dog Memorial 5k?

A: Several parking lots are within walking distance of the event site. Main parking will be off of Sheridan Ave. Additional parking will be available on the east side of Iron Horse Park, off of Wetzel Ave. Parking is free and is first-come-first-served. Please do not park at the Commissary or PX.

## Q: Is the War Dog Memorial 5k a rain or shine event?

A: Yes; please follow our Facebook Page for the latest updates on the event. By attending this event, you are assuming the risk of injury by inclement weather. The only time the event with be canceled will be due to an installation-wide post closure.

## Q: Can I bring my dog?

**A:** This run more than any other, dogs are welcome. Just make sure they are well-behaved, leashed, and vaccinated.

#### Q: Can I bring my stroller?

**A:** Yes! However, the course is a mix of pavement and trail with hills. We recommend using a jogging stroller.

#### Q: Is this run timed?

A: No. The next timed event will be the Army Ten Miler Qualifier on 07 May.

#### Q: Is there a 1 mile option?

A: No. The next event with a 1 mile option will be the War Dog Memorial on 21 May.

## Q: What time does the run start?

A: The run starts at 5:30pm. All participants must be on the course by 5:45pm.

# Q: Is there a Lost and Found? Is there a First Aid station? Lost Child?

A: Yes, the Lost & Found, First Aid, and Lost Child stations are located at the main stage.

## Q: Is the event open to the public?

A: No, the event is not open to the public. Gate access procedures apply for any DoD guests.
