# Colorado Springs Area

Nestled at the base of Pikes Peak, Colorado Springs offers families a mix of mountain adventures, military heritage, and wide-open skies. From red rock canyons to alpine lakes, nature is right outside your door.



## **Garden of the Gods**

This iconic park is famous for its towering red sandstone formations and sweeping views of Pikes Peak. Families can hike, bike, or join guided nature walks while spotting mule deer and birds. It's a breathtaking backdrop for outdoor play and family photos.

## **Pikes Peak**

Rising above the city at over 14,000 feet, Pikes Peak is a must-see. Families can drive, hike, or ride the cog railway to the summit for panoramic views stretching for miles. Along the way, enjoy alpine forests, picnic spots, and the thrill of being on top of the world.



## **Florissant Fossil Beds National Monument**

Just west of Colorado Springs, this monument preserves ancient giant redwood stumps and thousands of fossils. Families can explore easy trails, learn about prehistoric ecosystems, and connect with Colorado's deep natural history in a hands-on way.

## **Great Sand Dunes National Park and Preserve**

Just a few hours south of Colorado Springs, the tallest sand dunes in North America rise dramatically against snowcapped peaks. Families can sled down sandy slopes, splash in Medano Creek during spring and summer, and hike into alpine forests nearby. It's a one-of-a-kind playground where desert, mountains, and sky all meet.
