COMMUNITY HIGHLIGHT FEATURING

Mikayla Sanchez

Survivor: The Strength and Spirit of Mikayla Sanchez



Her dedication to nurturing others began more than two decades ago when she first joined Fort Carson's Child and Youth Services (CYS). Sanchez swiftly moved from a flex employee to a full-time provider, eventually becoming a beloved team lead often working in the Strong Beginnings classroom. Here, she taught more than letters and numbers; she taught empathy, resilience, and emotional awareness. "That's what we focus on in CYS," she explained, "social and emotional development. Because that's very important. It's how to interact with other people and how to be able to regulate your emotions—something you have to help children learn how to do." While pursuing her degree in early childhood education, which she obtained at the height of the COVID pandemic, Sanchez rose to Supervisory Program Specialist and finally to Assistant Director of the Monarch CDC. Her journey was not without its challenges, but as she openly admits, "It gets stressful—it does, but I love it, and I love the kids. That's where my heart is." Yet even the strongest hearts can be tested.

On a cold night in November 2022, Sanchez put on her favorite pair of pants, a stylish jacket, and a pair of black boots to go out to a club in Colorado Springs that had become a regular place for her to enjoy time with her friends and let loose. The night started like any other she had spent there. She danced and laughed with friends while enjoying the music being DJ'ed by her partner at the time. When gunfire suddenly erupted, the familiar warmth and levity of friendship turned abruptly into chaos and terror.



"As soon as I heard it...I couldn't even look in that direction," Sanchez recalled. "I instantly got up and I just ran straight to the door." Sanchez had often imagined scenarios like this and had made plans of where to run in case of just such an emergency, a grim preparation she described as "sad and terrifying."

Sanchez reached the exit at the same time as her then partner, who with no regard for her own safety guided Mikayla out the door first, ultimately saving her life. As bullets tore through the air, Sanchez and several others tumbled through the door as it opened, falling on top of one another in the chaos of making their escape. In a blur of adrenaline and disbelief, she stood and reached for her partner, desperate to hold on, but was urged forward with the words "Just run." As she looked behind her, flashes of gunfire illuminated the club's doors, a haunting image of

danger and survival etched forever into her memory. Sanchez fled to the safety of a nearby Walgreens, panic and shock overriding the growing pain in her leg. Only once they were safe at home, when her mother noticed blood, did Sanchez realize she had been shot.

"She said, 'I think you've been shot.' And I was like, 'What?'" Sanchez recounted, remembering the chilling moment when her confusion led to clarity and reality finally broke through. "Then it was like the adrenaline stopped, and I instantly felt it. I was like, 'Oh my god... there is a hole in the back of my leg." Doctors later decided it was safer to leave the bullet lodged inside her leg, a permanent reminder of her survival. Occasionally, she feels it—a physical echo of that night. But the emotional scars proved deeper. Simple sounds like ice from her kitchen ice maker dropping into a cup brought recollections of gunshots that turned into waves of panic and tears. Nightmares still persist years later, not just for Sanchez but for her young son Koah, too.

This was not Sanchez's first close encounter with violence. In October 2017, while in Las Vegas, she narrowly avoided being present at the Route 91 Harvest festival shooting. The memory of empty airplane seats the next day haunted her, a stark reminder of lives abruptly ended, of a fate narrowly escaped. Returning to the Colorado Springs club one year later, Sanchez

found herself face-to-face with her past. A bullet hole near the exit was nearly level with her head, a chilling detail that left her shaken, contemplating the thin line between survival and tragedy. Yet Sanchez refuses to let these events define her. She has watched how trauma has broken others, and she remains fiercely committed to living a life not dominated by fear or anger. She is determined to show her son strength and courage, insisting that fear will not win.

"I just know that I can't let this define me as a person," she emphasized. "Because I've seen what it's done to some people—it's destroyed them inside, and it's changed them, and I won't let that happen to me." In tribute to those lost, Sanchez wears a tattoo of five brightly colored hearts, each symbolizing a life tragically taken that night. Above them, proudly displayed, is the word: Survivor. "I want everybody to know that I wasn't a victim—but I was a survivor of this," Sanchez said.

To interact with Mikayla today, one would never imagine the level of resilience and quiet strength she utilizes to bring her best self forward each and every day. The brightness of her smile and warmth she exudes while dedicated to her mission of enriching and nurturing the lives of the children at the Monarch CDC in her "happy place", outshine all of the dark and harrowing experiences of her past. These extraordinary experiences will forever be a part of her story, but do not in themselves define her. What defines this incredible woman is the way in which she presses on with strength, warmth, and compassion each day.

She is a survivor, and now she is thriving; for herself, her son Koah, and for the Fort Carson community.




The Hub



Advance School Enrollment for Military Dependents

Inbound active-duty military members with orders to a Department of Defense installation in Colorado can utilize specific legislation to enroll their dependents in school remotely.

Key Highlights:

Remote Enrollment: Families can enroll electronically without appearing in person.

Residency Requirements: Orders cannot be used to establish residency, but enrollment may use the School Liaison Office address.

Required Documentation: Enrollment forms, proof of residency, and disciplinary records (due within 10 days of attendance).

Enrollment Opportunities: Access to specific schools, programs, courses, charter school enrollment, and open enrollment.

Additional Benefits: Guaranteed matriculation within the school or district.

Priority enrollment for younger siblings in future school years.






