Approving Authority	Discretion of the Unit, Directorate and Private Organization leadership
Criteria	• Brigade level Units can recognize up to five (5) of their "own" volunteers quarterly. • Tenant Battalions, Directorates and Private Organizations can recognize up to two (2) of their volunteers quarterly. • This award is reserved for the Unit/Directorate/Organization's top Volunteers of the Quarter. • Submissions by Commander/Director will be selected. • No minimum hours are required, but volunteer(s) must be registered in VMIS with hours tracked there as well. • Battalions, Directorates and Private Organizations are responsible to submit quarterly packets NLT suspense date for appropriate processing.
Submission Packet	Submitted individual award packet "must" be signed by the Commander and/or Director with: • The Volunteer's name, organization, address, telephone, email • Dates for period of volunteer service (within the calendar year). • Justification memorandum of noteworthy accomplishments that denote the impact on the unit/ directorate/private organization's operation with the respective quarter.
