#### Facility manager refresher training

The refresher training is for certified military facility managers who have attended the two-day DPW Facility Management Class.

The training will provide updates on service order processing; work requests; energy and water conservation; recycling; and fire prevention safety (Fire Warden) responsibilities. Those who have taken DPW Facility Management Class within the last 12 months do not need to take the refresher training until the next year.

The contest format is a drawing for an Exchange gift card from contest entry forms collected Nov. 1-15. The winning entry form will be drawn the week of Nov. 15 and the winner will be notified.

Fort Carson community members (Soldiers, Family members, contractors, civilian employees and retirees – DOD ID card holders) can bring recyclables from home to compete in the drawing. Recyclables accepted include cardboard, mixed paper (white paper, newspaper, magazines, shredded paper, junk mail, etc.), aluminum, tin, plastic and glass. The Exchange recycle location is open Monday-Sunday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. and is closed on federal holidays. Customers can leave their contest entry form with the attendant working on site. #### **Energy Action Month**

Each temperature degree adjustment (a degree warmer during cooling season and a degree colder during heating season) saves up to 3 percent in utility costs. (Source U.S. Army) If Fort Carson buildings occupants encounter routine energy and water-related issues, such as too hot or cold temperatures, leaking faucets, etc., they can submit a service order for repair through the Army Maintenance Application (ArMA), at

https://www.armymaintenance.com/arma. Priority 1/ emergency service orders must be called in to the DPW operations and maintenance contractor at 719-526-5345, which is staffed 24/7, to ensure issues are addressed promptly.



#### MILITARY AND FAMILY LIFE COUNSELOR PROGRAM

Military families face unique challenges. They may struggle with issues such as deployment-related stress, reintegration and pressures of managing parenting and finances while a loved one is deployed.

To support military families facing these or additional challenges, the MFLC program:

- » Provides short-term, non-medical counseling services to service members and their families at no cost
- » Provides psycho-education to help military service members and their families understand the impact of deployments, family reunions following deployments and other stresses related to the military life
- » Augments existing military support services
- » Offers flexible service delivery
- » Can provide services on or off of military installations
- » Can provide services to individuals, couples, families and groups

With the exception of child abuse, domestic abuse and duty to warn situations services are private and confidential.
