

Barr Trail is a 12+ mile (oneway) hike gaining over 7,800 vertical feet from Manitou Springs to the 14,115-foot summit of Pikes Peak - America's Mountain.

BEAUTIFUL HIKING

RED ROCK CANYON OPEN SPACE

Red Rock Canyon is characterized by a series of canyons and ridges sculpted by erosion of the area's uplifted rock strata. The ridges and canyons offer beautiful views and sheltered enclaves for inspiration, varied terrain for recreation, and a 240 million year slice of sedimentary geology for education. 789 acres accommodates hiking, climbing, cycling, and horseback riding, as well as offering picnic areas, and a bicycle free ride area.

TRAIN LIKE AN OLYMPIAN MANITOU INCLINE

The Manitou Springs Incline, also known as the Manitou Incline or simply the Incline, is a popular hiking trail rising above Manitou Springs, Colorado, near Colorado Springs.

PAINT MINES INTERPRETIVE PARK

Recognized as a unique experience, the Paint Mines Interpretive Park is one of El Paso County's most popular open spaces.

Located on 750 acres in the sweeping plains of eastern El Paso County, the mines have evidence of human life as far back as 9,000 years ago. The colorful clays were used for making pottery and ceremonial paints.
