<ul> <li>Most of the time there is a mixture of both responses</li> <li>Children: clingy; sleep disturbances; eating difficulties; crankiness; academic struggles; acting out; self-criticism; loss of interestacademic struggles; acting out; self-criticism; loss of interest</li> </ul>		
Anticipation of Return		
<ul> <li>Homecoming is coming!</li> <li>Family is happy, excited, and feeling boost of energy</li> <li>Sense of relief that the Service member will be home combined with worries about whether or not he or she will be the same</li> <li>Children: age-appropriate preparation for when the Service members return home</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Excitement</li> <li>Anticipation</li> <li>Apprehension</li> <li>Nervousness</li> <li>Restlessness</li> <li>Indecision</li> <li>Irritability</li> </ul>
