





CURRENT AND FORMER SERVICE MEMBERS - MAKE A DIFFERENCE Mentor Children of America's Fallen Military Heroes

TAPS Mountain State Regional Military Survivor Seminar and Good Grief Camp
March 29-31 in Colorado Spring, CO

BACKGROUND: The <u>Tragedy Assistance Program for Survivors (TAPS)</u> is the national nonprofit caring for the families of America's fallen heroes. Since 1994, TAPS has provided comfort and hope 24/7 through a national peer support network and connection to grief programming and resources at no cost to surviving military families. We have assisted more than 85,000 surviving family members, casualty officers, and battle buddies.

THE SURVIVOR PROGRAM: At the Mountain State Regional Military Survivor Seminar and Good Grief Camp, surviving military family members from across the region will come together and connect with others who have experienced similar losses. Children ages 4-18 create lasting friendships, learn coping skills, build resiliency, and honor their fallen service member. Group lessons combine team building, sharing, and playing to create an environment where children feel safe to explore their grief. Pairing each child with their own mentor is the key to our success.

MILITARY MENTOR ROLE: Current and former service members are eligible to volunteer for this incredible opportunity. After a group training session with TAPS Youth Programs staff, mentors are paired with their own mentee and work in small groups facilitated by an experienced leader. You may request the age group you'd like to work with. Children learn through active play, and the curriculum is designed to meet each child where they are in the grief process through engaging activities. The one-on-one time with your mentee gives them the companionship and support needed to feel comfortable connecting with peers and engaging in lessons. This video shows the impact of the Good Grief Camp on our voungest survivors.

MILITARY MENTOR SCHEDULE:



CAREER SKILLS PROGRAM

The Fort Carson Career Skills Program (CSP) offers opportunities for eligible transitioning service members to gain the knowledge, skills and abilities needed for successful careers after they transition from active duty. To be eligible for any CSP, transitioning service members must be on active duty and within 180 days of transitioning from service as of the class start date, anticipate fully honorable or under honorable conditions discharge and have approval of the first field grade commander in their chain to participate. Each program also has additional eligibility criteria. Interested transitioning service members are encouraged to attend the appropriate information session as indicated below. They can also visit the Career Skills Program Office (building 6236, rooms 101-104) Monday-Friday, 7 a.m. to 4 p.m.




