#### **EDUCATION CENTER - POST 9-11 GI BILL TRANSFERABILITY CHANGES**

IMORTANT UPDATE: Post 9-11 GI Bill Transferability Changes – Effective 12 July 2019 Effective 12 July 2019, the transfer of Post 9/11 VA Education Benefits will be limited to Service Members with less than 16 years time in Service. Service Members are still required to have at least 6 years TIS to transfer to family members, and must serve an additional 4 year service obligation from the date of transfer. Soldiers who have received a Purple Heart on/after 11 September 2001 and are still serving can submit a TEB request regardless of years served or years of retainability. 




