EDUCATION CENTER - POST 9-11 GI BILL TRANSFERABILITY EXTENSION

The initial July 12 transferability deadline has been extended to Jan. 12, 2020. The transfer of Post 9/11 VA education benefits will be limited to service members with less than 16 years of time in service (TIS). Service members are still required to have at least six years TIS to transfer to Family Members, and must serve an additional four-year service obligation from the date of transfer. Soldiers still serving who received a Purple Heart on or after Sept. 11, 2001, can submit a transfer of education benefits request regardless of years served or years of retainability.
