IDES / SRU Soldiers SFAC Timeline

Integrated Disability Evaluation System (IDES) & Soldier Recovery Unit (SRU) Soldiers Transition Process

Your transition through the IDES process is important to the Army Community Service Soldier & Family Assistance Center (SFAC). Please review the following information to ensure your transition is successful.

1 In Processing: Call to schedule an appointment, 719-526-5807/524-7301
New IDES/SRU Soldiers MUST in-process the SFAC.

2 Transition Briefing Last Wednesday of the month or by appointment.
10:00-11:00 a.m., ACS Center, BLDG 1526.

Once you know your Army Disability Rating or after signing your final DA Form 199 Soldiers MUST attend the "Transition Briefing".

3 Leave Calculation Appointment

By appointment only—scheduled by SFAC staff.

Appointment scheduled after DA Form 199 is reviewed AND final approval for discharge from Physical Disability Agency (PDA) is made.

**Please ensure that ALL requested documents are submitted to the SFAC Staff on time.*

4 Orders

Within 7 working days of hitting the TRANSPROC Roster, the Soldier will receive their orders from the Fort Carson Transitions Center. Installation Final Out Date (clearing) is typically set within 1 month of hitting the TRANSPROC Roster.
