- Ensure financial documents are complete and accurate, returning documents that are submitted that are incomplete or incorrect
- Provide accepted Unit Transmittal Letters to the section Non-Commissioned Officer
- Conduct in-processing PCS out-processing finance transactions
- Provide timely and accurate military pay processing services
- Comply with the Privacy Act and all applicable agency regulations on individual privacy QUALIFICAIONS / EDUCATION / SKILLS:
 - Support service / customer service experience desired
 - Military background / familiarity preferred
 - Quality control experience preferred

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:
