IVY WARRIOR RESTAURANT UPDATES

Fort Carson Ivy Warrior Restaurants (IWR) have scheduled closures on the following dates for quarterly fire suppression checks:

--James R. Wolf IWR (building 1444) - July 31

--Robert C. Stack IWR (building 2330) – Aug. 7

--Warfighter IWR (building 9439) – Aug. 14

All Ivy Warrior Restaurants (Robert C. Stack, building 2330; James R. Wolf, building 1444; and Warfighter, building 9439) operate seven days a week and serve "grab and go" only to reduce contact exposure and minimize the risk within each facility.

- Monday-Friday - breakfast from 7-9 a.m. (Warfighter 7:30-9 a.m.), lunch from 11:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. and dinner from 5:30-7 p.m.

- Weekends and federal/training holidays - brunch from 9:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. and supper from 5:30-7:00 p.m.

The LaRoche Dining Facility has reopened. Hours are:

- Monday-Friday: breakfast 7-9 a.m., lunch 11:30 a.m. to 1 p.m.; no dinner.

- Weekends: closed

RIDE SHARES

Effective immediately, ride share drivers are allowed to pick up DOD identification card holders on the installation.

Prior to this change, ride share drivers could only drop off DOD ID card holders on Fort Carson.

All other access control requirements remain in effect.

POLICE RECORDS IN-PERSON SERVICE

The Fort Carson Police Records section will resume serving customers in-person as of July 22. The Police Records section is located at building 2757, Osan Street, MOD 4. It is open Monday-Friday from 9 a.m. to noon and 1-4 p.m., excluding federal holidays. The office will also be closed July 31. Due to COVID-19 safety guidelines, the staff will be serving one customer at a time, customers will be required to wear a mask while in the building, wait times are expected to be longer than normal, and the section will be closed the last five minutes of every hour for sanitization. Before visiting the Fort Carson Police Records section, customers can contact them at 526-8289 to ensure they are the appropriate place to fulfill the customer's request and that all required documents are brought to the office for it to be processed.

GRAB-N'-GO LUNCHEAS ARE NOW AVAILABLE AT PIKES PEAK LIBRARY DISTRICT - EAST LIBRARY

Monday - Friday from 11 a.m. - noon. The meals are provided by District 11 and are available for children ages 1 - 18. Children do not need to be present for an adult to pick up meals, nor do they have to stay in the vicinity to consume the meals. Both breakfast and lunch options will be available during this time. FORT CARSON MOTORCYCLE LICENSES

Due to a recent increase in accidents and mishaps, Fort Carson active-duty, military-member motorcyclists must obtain a Fort Carson Motorcycle License, through their unit motorcycle mentor, to ride legally on or off post. The policy, which affects military personnel only, is effective immediately. Military members who are new to the installation will have a 30-day grace period to obtain the new license. RSO/OIC CARD EXPIRATION

Fort Carson's Range Officer has extended the expiration dates on officer in charge (OIC) or range safety officer (RSO) cards due to reduced number of training seats available. People with an expiration date between March 19 and Sept. 29 on RSO/OIC and/or Maneuver Damage, Range Operations will automatically extend the expiration date(s) until Sept. 30. If a leader was/is promoted, they are responsible for updating the change with Range Operations.

RSO/OIC TRAINING

Fort Carson's Directorate of Plans, Training, Mobilization and Security Range Operations has resumed the RSO/OIC course at McMahon Auditorium. The maximum capacity is 100 people due to COVID-19. Attendance will be on a first-come, first-served basis. Doors will open at noon and then closed when capacity has been met, and the class will start at 1 p.m. The current class schedule is: July 28 and 30, and Aug. 4, 6, 11, 13, 18 and 20. These additional classes are being offered to facilitate the OIC/RSO requirements for training on Fort Carson and Piñon Canyon Maneuver Site. Starting July 1, the Ellis Outdoor Pool will be open for recreation swim from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday- Sunday. The max capacity will be 50 patrons. In order to allow as many patrons as possible throughout the day, swimmers will be limited to 1 hour and 45-minute time blocks that will start at 9:00 a.m., 11:00 a.m., 1:00 p.m. and 3:00 p.m. Entry will be on a first come, first serve basis. All patrons will clear the facility after their time block. Patrons must wear a mask or face covering when waiting to enter the facility and while socializing with people outside of their immediate family on the pool deck. The slide, diving board and baby pools will be closed.

The Ivy family pool will be open for recreation swim beginning 1 July. No recreation swim will occur in the Ivy main pool. The max capacity is 12 patrons. Like the Ellis Outdoor Pool, patrons will be restricted to a 1 hour and 45-minute time block beginning at 9:00 a.m. and ending at 9:00 p.m. weekdays and 7:00 p.m. weekends.

Children must be able to pass a swim test or meet the height requirement to swim without a parent in the water. Life jackets must be U.S. Coast Guard approved. Children in life jackets must be accompanied by a parent in the water regardless of pool depth. No inflatables of any kind are allowed per AR 215-1. Normal fees apply. Annual Pass Holders will receive pass extensions for time lost due to the closure, please see a lifeguard for more information.

For: Beginner to intermediate level hikers

Location to hike: Cabin Canyon, Siamese Twins, Palmer and Central Garden Trail loop.

Length: 4.7 miles

Estimated time: 2hrs 30 min hiking plus 10 min of stretching

Elevation gain: 616 feet

Description of the trail: moderately trafficked loop trail located 14 miles from Fort Carson that offers the chance to see wildlife and is rated as moderate.

Dog Friendly: Dogs are able to use this trail but must be kept on leash. Don't forget to bring dog waste bags.

What to wear (recommended): Hiking shoes or sneakers, light hiking socks, short sleeves and shorts, or choose breathable, lightweight long sleeves and pants if you're worried about bugs or sun exposure. Hat, wind proof outer layer and sunglasses.

What to bring (recommended): Backpack, lightweight jacket, sunscreen, water, **face mask**, healthy snacks (banana, apple, beef jerky or trail mix), and multi-tool.

BILL SHUEY

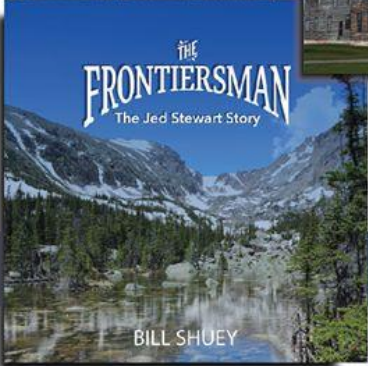

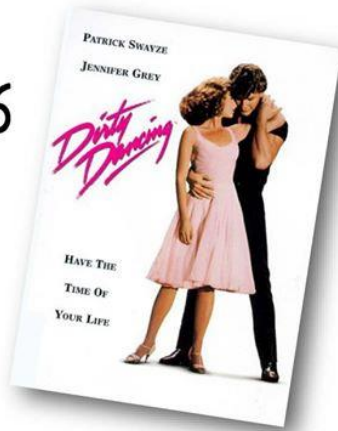

My Career Advancement Account Helping Spouses Reach Career Goals

The My Career Advancement Account Scholarship is a workforce development program that provides up to \$4,000 of tuition assistance to eligible military spouses. The scholarship assists military spouses in pursuing licenses, certifications or associate degrees necessary to gain employment in an occupation or career field. Spouses may use their My Career Advancement Account Scholarship funds at any academic institution approved for participation in the scholarship.

Fast Facts

The My Career Advancement Account Scholarship provides a maximum tuition benefit of \$4,000 with an annual fiscal year cap of \$2,000 to assist eligible military spouses who need professional credentials to meet their career goals. Annual cap waivers are available for licensure and certificate programs if there is an upfront tuition cost that exceeds \$2,000, up to the maximum education benefit of \$4,000.

Who is eligible for the My Career Advancement Account Scholarship?

Spouses of service members on active duty in pay grades E-1 to E-5, W-1 to W-2 and O-1 to O-2 who have successfully completed high school and have the ability to request tuition assistance while their military sponsor is on Title 10 military orders are eligible. Spouses married to members of the National Guard and reserves in these same pay grades are eligible.

Those who are *not eligible* include the following:

- Spouses who are married but legally separated, or under court order or statute of any state or U.S. territory, from a member of the armed forces on Title 10 orders
- Spouses whose National Guard or reserves military sponsor is in a warning orders or alert, post-deployment, demobilization or transition status

The My Career Advancement Account Scholarship will NOT pay for the following:

- Tuition for courses and examinations not included in the spouse's Education and Training Plan and courses already started or completed by the spouse
- Reimbursements of any kind
- Books, supplies, equipment, uniforms, computers and electronic devices of any kind
- Student activities, events and entertainment
- Prepayment or deposits for future courses, unless costs are part of a block of study

The My Career Advancement Account Scholarship will NOT pay for the following continued...

- School or college level entrance examinations, comprehensive exams and related preparatory courses
- Courses, tests or fees normally paid by an employer as part of a job training program
- Fees of any kind, including but not limited to registration fees, technology fees, parking fees, etc.
- Nonacademic credit or ungraded courses, including courses taken on an audit basis or as an internship, practicum, apprenticeship or clinical supervision; also, nonacademic credit or ungraded orientation programs
- Courses taken more than one time, unless the My Career Advancement Account Scholarship has received a full refund from the school
- Academic credit by examination
- General studies, liberal arts and interdisciplinary associate degrees that do not have a concentration
- Personal enrichment courses, excluding academic credit or graded electives in the spouse's Education and Training Plan
- Transportation, lodging, child care and medical services
- Course extensions, except for approved hardship waivers
- Study-abroad programs, excluding programs of study offered by participating My Career Advancement Account Scholarship schools on overseas military installations
- Private licenses. For example, a private pilot's license would not be covered because it is for recreational use, but a commercial pilot's license would be covered because it would be used for an occupation.
- High school completion programs, including online high school completion programs
- Continuing education credits to maintain a standing in a professional organization

The My Career Advancement Account Scholarship program is part of the Department of Defense Spouse Education and Career Opportunities program that offers comprehensive coaching, information, tools and resources to support military spouse career exploration, education, training and licensing, employment readiness and career connections.

How to establish an account with the My Career Advancement Account Scholarship

Spouses can visit the My Career Advancement Account Scholarship website at <https://mycaa.militaryonesource.mil/mycaa> and provide the required Spouse Profile information. All scholarship participants are required to use DS Logon to access their accounts. Military spouses enrolled in the Defense Enrollment Eligibility Reporting System, or DEERS, are eligible for a DS Logon account. 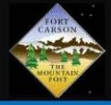
