INTERNSHIP SUMMARY



An Internship through VeteranPCS is designed to educate, inspire, and prepare you to start a new career as a real estate agent. The structure of the internship gives you guidance and direction but requires you to be proactive, work at your own pace, problem solve, network, and take responsibility for your own success.

Internships are available for Active Duty, Veterans, and Military Spouses

For Career Skills Program and Skill Bridge Internships you must be within 180 days of separating from active duty service. Your internship may extend beyond your separation date.

Internships are Individual and custom made to fit your schedule and timeline. Eight weeks is standard but may be adjusted depending on time availability.

Internships can be in your current location or set up for the city/state where you want to start your career.
