

Housekeeping

Overview:

The housekeeper promotes sanitary conditions which prevent the spread of infection and odors. She/he may be required to perform tasks, which involve exposure to visible blood contamination or reasonably anticipated blood contamination. The housekeeper must follow the required procedures for handling, cleaning, disposing, or moving of objects/materials and/or the clean-up of blood, infectious materials, or body fluids containing blood in accordance with the OSHA Blood-borne Pathogen Standard or SRM Policies and Procedures.

Physical Requirements:

This position demands good physical and mental health. The housekeeper will be required to lift, carry, walk, sit, push, pull and work a flexible schedule, must be able to move continuously during work hours and able to lift and/or carry 50 to 75 pounds.

Duties:

Basic cleaning and straightening of the billeting rooms shall occur. Housekeeping staff shall perform daily and weekly cleaning tasks in the break-room, lobby, corridors, and the student lounge area. Additional 'as needed' tasks, less frequent cleaning tasks, and amplified cleaning instructions are detailed below:

- Remove Trash & Recyclables: All wastebaskets and recycle containers shall be emptied, cleaned and returned to their original position every Wednesday and Sunday. Trash and recyclables removed shall be emptied in the outside collection point (trash and recycle dumpsters) using larger, wheeled collection bins.
- Vacuum, Cleaning, and Spot Treatment of Carpets and Upholstery: Vacuum the entire carpet area so that all visible litter and soil is removed. Where it is necessary, office furniture, wastebaskets, and easily moved items shall be moved to vacuum underneath. These items shall be returned to their original location after vacuuming is complete.
- Emergency cleaning of certain areas necessitated by inadvertent spills on the carpet (no
 matter how large an area) shall be done immediately. Spills shall be cleaned with cold
 water immediately so stains will not set in carpet fibers. If carpets cannot be cleaned to
 standards from a recent spill. Immediately report the incident to the CTC Housing
 Manager on a Maintenance Request Form. Report all carpet tears, burns, and raveling
 immediately.
- Sweep, Vacuum, Mop Floor: The entire floor surface including corners and abutments shall be swept free of litter, dust, dry dirt and other types of debris. Moveable items shall be moved in order to sweep underneath and then returned to their original
