The Fort Carson ACS Financial Readiness Program offers a variety of services such as one-on-one appointments addressing retirement plans, debt reduction, and emergency financial situations, including access to the Army Emergency Relief program. Financial Readiness also provides financial education, budget assistance, personalized budget counseling, credit counseling and debt management along with a host of many other personal financial topics.

By Appointment	Setting Money Goals		As a Soldier, now is the time to enhance your financial knowledge and learn how to save and invest your valuable earnings, establish savings goals, discover debt elimination strategies, create a savings for emergency situations, and learn the value of Army Emergency Relief (AER). This class is open to all new Soldiers, their Family members and DoD ID holders.
Monthly	Understanding Your Credit Score	1st Tuesday 9:30am - 11:00am	This class ensures Soldiers understand the importance of credit and why credit should be a part of their financial knowledge. If your credit score is less than 700, take this class to increase your financial knowledge and increase your purchasing power.
Monthly	Understanding Your Military Retirement Thrift Savings Plan	1st Thursday 1:00pm - 2:00pm	In this class you will learn about the Thrift Savings Plan (TSP) and the different options that are available to you within this program. Learn about the Retirement Plan and how this can or cannot fit in with your TSP. With the help of certified financial counselors, you will be able to understand how to build and secure your financial future as a single Soldier or married Soldier with or without children.
Monthly	Financial Strength Budgeting 101	2nd Wednesday 10:00am - 11:00am	If you've never thought of having a budget, this class will help you learn how to create your own specific to your needs. Designed to ensure that each Soldier has a plan to better manage their money and create a sound financial plan. Family members are welcome to attend.
Weekly	Financial Touchpoint & Milestone Disabling Sickness or Condition	Every Wednesday 11:00am	This class focuses on the financial implications of dealing with a disabling sickness or condition - and helps you manage your finances more efficiently as you work through it. Being informed improves your understanding of the challenges your family might face.
Portable Class or By Appointment	Financial Touchpoints & Milestones	To schedule any of these classes as a portable class to your unit footprint or a 1-on-1, call (719) 524-4601	These classes are designed to increase your knowledge on each of the Common Military Milestones/Touchpoints: Pre-Deployment, Post-Deployment, PCS, Marriage, Divorce, Vesting in the TSP, Promotion, First Child, Continuation Pay, and Disabling Sickness or Condition. The Common Military Milestones/Touchpoints cover various lifestyles you may face during your military career.

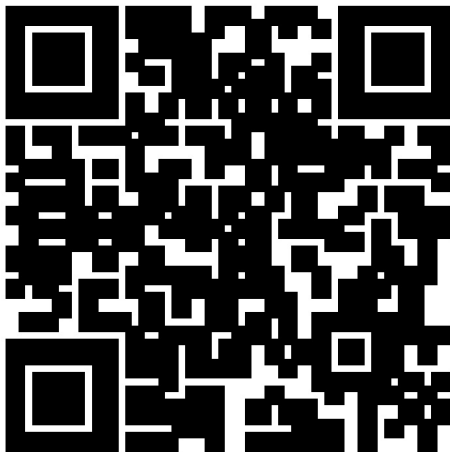
