








Once downloaded, select Fort Carson as your installation and you are ready to start taking advantage of the new app. **NOTE:** Fort Carson is no longer updating the Digital Garrison App.

Effective Sept. 1, 2025, personnel found to be speeding in excess of 20 mph over the applicable speed limit will have their driving privileges suspended for a period of up to one year. The speed limit is 30 mph in the main cantonment and 20 mph in housing areas unless otherwise posted. The maximum speed limit on Fort Carson is 40 mph.

4ID to conduct noise-generating training Soldiers from the 3rd Armored Brigade Combat Team, 4th Infantry Division, will conduct field artillery training on Fort Carson now until Nov. 7. An increase in noise and dust can be expected during the day and throughout the night south of main post. The training is required to validate armored vehicle crews and is a regular part of the 3ABCT's training cycle.

You can pick up a Military Annual Pass for free at many national parks and federal recreation sites. You'll need to bring one of three valid forms of identification:

- Unexpired Common Access Card (CAC)
- Unexpired DD Form 1173
- Unexpired Next Generation Dependent ID (Replacement of DD Form 1173)

To receive your pass by mail, order online at the USGS Store for a \$10 processing fee. Passes ordered from the USGS Store are not digital passes and may take weeks to ship.

When: Sept. 18, 2025, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Where: At building 3710 just north and west of Gate 20 off Specker Avenue near the tank trail

How: Drop off all unwanted, unclassified paper, including old bank statements, credit card offers, cancelled checks, old medical records, pay stubs, etc., to shred it and get rid of it.

(No classified documents will be accepted.) The event is free and open to all ID card holders.

Ensure documents brought in are free of trash and non-paper items (binders, paper clips, plastic bags, etc.) for ease of processing.

Military units and tenants are limited to no more than one stake bed truck load each per event.

No semi-trucks loads will be accepted.

Why: The event is used provide a venue for shredding and recycling of paper. Come do your part to help Fort Carson reduce waste from going to the landfill!






