AM I ELIGIBLE TO APPLY?

- · You must be within a year of separation*
- You must be on active duty for the duration of the 12-week program
- You need either a bachelor's or associate's degree OR a highly desired skill set.
- * Your fellowship must begin within 180 days prior to separation.


