CORPORATE FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM

AM I ELIGIBLE TO APPLY?

- You must be within a year of separation*
- You must be on active duty for the duration of the 12-week program
- You need either a bachelor's or associate's degree OR a highly desired skill set.

* Your fellowship must begin within 180 days prior to separation.



THE SCHEDULE

Monday - Thursday you work in a mid to senior level professional position, matched to your skills and experience, with a host company in one of our locations.

Friday is spent with your cohort and at partner companies, gaining corporate skills and networking. You'll also have the opportunity to take a certification track course through our partner Simplilearn
