





#### It's a New Year! Are You Ready to Set Your Employment Goals?

If you are making a career change, looking for gainful employment or re-entering the workforce, the New Year is a great time to sit down, take stock of your goals and commit them to paper.

Once you've identified your goals employ the SMART method to ensure they are: Specific, Measureable, Achievable, Relevant & Time-Bound



#### Tips on How to Reach Your Employment Goals

- 1. Stay Focused. Seek out positions you are qualified for. As tempting as it is to apply for any and all positions, especially when your search stalls. You may not be hired because you're not a good fit for the jobs you're applying for.
- 2. Meet new people. Meet 2-3 new people a week who may help with your job search. New people open new opportunities, new leads & ideas. This can be over the phone, virtually and in person. LinkedIn is a great way to connect with hiring officials, managers and professional groups.
- 3. Follow up on all job leads. Treat everyone you meet as someone who can potentially help you with your job search. Share your job search journey with friends and neighbors, they may know someone you want to
- 4. Set up Informational Interviews. Talk to hiring officials, managers and people who have the same type of position you're looking for. Find out what you can about companies, jobs and people.
- 5. There's always room for improvement. Have your resume reviewed. There may be a reason you're not getting called/referred, you can't change what you don't know needs change. Contact an ERP Specialist and request a resume review.
- 6. Treat looking for a job as your full-time job. Commit to investing the time it takes for research, job search and networking.
- 7. Build a job search plan. Be Organized. Outline people to contact, set time to do job research, develop a schedule, and set up milestones.
- 8. Set up a 'Cheer' section. Looking for work can leave you feeling disheartened and exhausted. Develop your circle of trust you can talk to, people who will cheer you on and encourage you.
- 9. Pursue education and continue to learn. Use this time to pursue a certificate, earn or complete a degree. Become a Subject Matter Expert (SME) in your field. Improve your skills and build new ones.
- 10. Use all tools at your disposal. Use Employment Readiness classes, workshops and services. Fort Carson ACS Employment Readiness Program Specialists are Certified Federal Job Search Trainers (CFJST) & Certified Federal Job Career Coaches (CFJCC) who specialize in federal & private sector resume writing & review. ERP Specialists are also able to assist with job search, interview preparation, career assessment, professional development & more. ERP holds a number of classes and professional development workshops designed to support your employment goals.





#### **ARE YOU ABOUT TO PCS?**

AER can help Active Duty Soldiers, Active Guard and Reserve Soldiers\*, and their Families, with zero-interest loans, grants, or a combination of both.

\*Title 10 orders for at least 31 consecutive days. Exceptions may apply. Talk to your nearest Military Aid Office.

#### **AER CAN HELP**

AER can help with expenses before, during, and after a PCS, such as auto repair, rent deposit, temporary lodging, appliance repair, child care assistance, spouse relicensing, and more.



Assistance for pet-boarding may be offered as an exception.

Talk to your nearest AER officer to learn more.



#### **HOW TO APPLY**

3 ways to receive assistance from AER:

- 1. Talk to your Chain of Command
- 2. Visit your nearest AER office at armyemergencyrelief.org/offices
- 3. Call the American Red Cross at 1-877-272-7337

#### **DETAILS ABOUT PET BOARDING**

- AER may provide assistance for pet boarding fees, as an exception, for Soldiers affected by the COVID-19 pre & post PCS 14-day quarantine (Restriction of Movement)
- Pet boarding assistance may be provided for up to 15 days pre and post PCS (30 days total)
- Requests for more than 30 days of pet boarding will be forwarded to HQ AER for
- Soldiers must provide an estimate of the pet boarding costs
- Assistance may be provided as a zero-interest loan, grant, or combination of both
