



REMINDER: The USAG Fort Carson DFMWR sponsored All-Terrain Vehicle Course near Gate 20 is closed and has been turned over to the 4th Infantry Division to use as a military training area. Privately owned and operated ATVs are no longer authorized in this area.

Paper Shredding Event

The Directorate of Public Works (DPW) is hosting a paper shredding event April 22 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. at building 3710 north of Gate 20 off of Specker Avenue as part of the national Earth Day observance. Note: COVID-19 social distancing and masks are required on site during drop off of paper. Post community members can bring all unwanted, unclassified paper, including old bank statements, credit card offers, cancelled checks, old medical records, pay check stubs, etc., to shred it, recycle it and help Fort Carson reduce waste going to the landfill. The event is free and open to all ID card holders. No classified documents will be accepted. Ensure documents brought in are free of trash and non-paper items (binders, paper clips, etc.) for ease of processing.

An asphalt mill and overlay project

on MSR-1 is scheduled for April 12 through Aug. 31 (timeline subject to change). Work will be conducted with a rolling lane closure. Only portions of one lane will be closed at a time. Both lanes will be open daily from 5 p.m. to 7 a.m. Work will start at Essayons Intersection and work south. The project encompasses 17 miles of MSR-1. Online Visitor Pass Portal

The Directorate of Emergency Services now offers an online visitor portal for visitors to apply for an installation access pass. Visitors can go to https://visit.gvt.us to apply online for a pass from their computer or mobile device. Visitors will still receive a background check, and after entering their information, including a driver's license or passport number, they will be notified if their pass is approved or denied. If approved, they can proceed to a kiosk at Visitor Control Center 1 for their photo to be taken and the issuance of their pass. Although a sponsor is not required when applying for a pass online, visitors will still require a valid purpose for visiting Fort Carson. This could include visiting family or friends, food delivery, medical appointment or attending a ceremony.

COVID-19 Vaccine Scheduling

TRICARE beneficiaries age 18 and up can now schedule their COVID-19 vaccine appointments at Fort Carson using the DHA Appointing Portal (DAP) at https://informatics-stage.health.mil/COVAX/

If you would like to schedule your appointment by phone, call the COVID-19 Vaccine Appointment Line Monday-Friday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. at 719-503-0820.

All COVID-19 vaccine appointments will be conducted at the William "Bill" Reed Special Events Center (SEC), located at 6550 Specker Ave., building 1829. The vaccination site is open from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

All vaccinations are by appointment only; walk-ins are not permitted. Remember to bring your DOD ID card and CDC vaccination card if receiving the second dose. Masks are also required.

Scheduling with DAP is limited to TRICARE beneficiaries. Active-duty service members, Evans Army Community Hospital employees and U.S. Army Garrison Fort Carson employees should still schedule their vaccination through their chains of command and return for their second vaccination on the day marked on their CDC vaccination card from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. If a service member or employee is unable to return on their designated day, they should walk in to the SEC immediately following the return date.



GET HELP BUYING FOOD FOR YOUR FAMILY

Did you know benefits could be available to you? The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) is an on-going monthly food benefit that helps Colorado families to afford healthy food when budgets are tight. SNAP gives you options--you can choose where to shop and what to buy. These benefits are for you!

SNAP is For You

SNAP is available for all eligible families. You can receive SNAP benefits if you have limited income or high living expenses. If you are an immigrant, receiving SNAP for eligible children (such as US Citizen kids) does not impact public charge. Visit KeepYourBenefits.org for more information about immigration and benefits.

Many Coloradoans use SNAP. There is enough for all who are eligible--it's just waiting for you to use it!





Fill out a SNAP application

You can apply online for SNAP benefits using the Colorado PEAK website <u>colorado.gov/PEAK</u> or on your smartphone using the MyCOBenefits app. You can download the app from the Apple or Android app store.

If your family qualifies for SNAP, you might also qualify for Pandemic EBT (additional funds for groceries to support children) this year! Learn more at cdhs.colorado.gov/p-ebt

Additional Pandemic Resources




