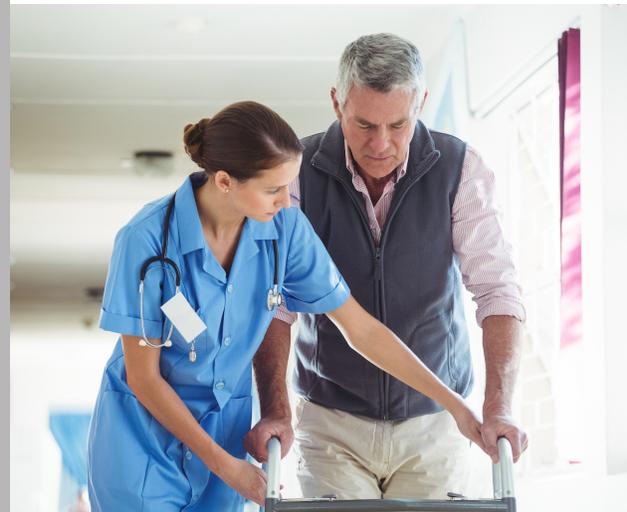

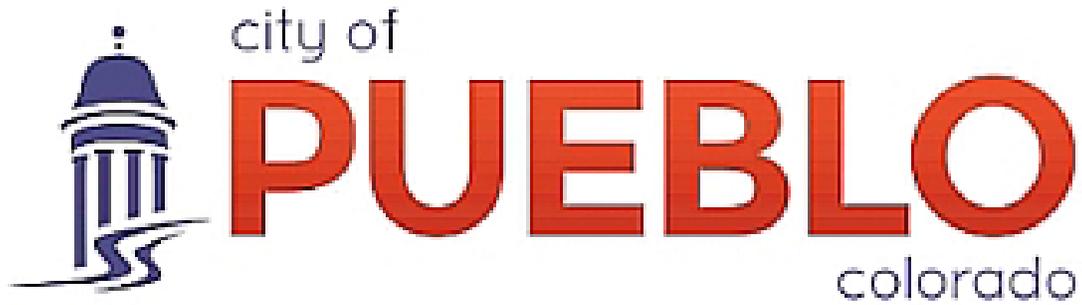

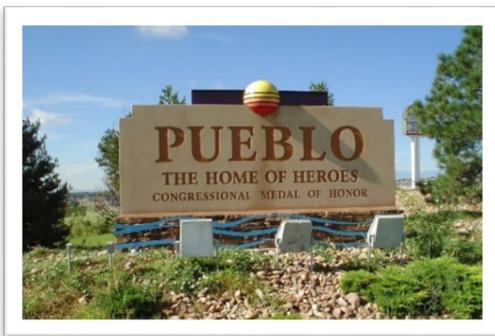

Outreach Coordinator

POSITION DESCRIPTION:

The primary focus of this position will be to strengthen relationships with local artists and arts organizations, arts patrons, community partners, cultural tourists, and other arts & cultural stakeholders to increase engagement with Cultural Office programs and services. The Outreach Coordinator will also work closely with other staff members to support a wide variety of Cultural Office initiatives. Learn more about our work at CulturalOffice.org.

REPORTING RELATIONSHIP:

Reports to Executive Director, but also takes direction from Communications Director.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Position responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- **Community Convenings:** The Outreach Coordinator will work with the Executive Director to develop and produce a new series of gatherings for local creatives that will provide additional opportunities for socializing, networking, professional development, and/or cross-disciplinary collaboration. This position will also support existing Cultural Office convenings, such as the Business + Arts Lunch, Coffee with COPPeR, etc.
- **Community Connections:** In the office, the Outreach Coordinator will be the first line of customer service for our organization, answering incoming phone calls, responding to requests for information, and greeting visitors to our office in the Plaza of the Rockies. Outside of the office, this individual will seek out opportunities to cultivate connections and create collaborations with local artists and arts organizations.
- **Arts Vision 2030 Action Items:** The Outreach Coordinator will identify and support the development of new partnership opportunities that will further implementation of the community-defined priorities and strategies that are suggested in [Arts Vision 2030](#), our region's 10-year cultural plan.
- **Peak Radar Support:** The Outreach Coordinator will work with other Cultural Office staff members to edit and approve user-submitted content to PeakRadar.com; solicit new listings for the website; grow e-blast and social media subscribers; update and maintain the website's Public Art, Venue, Organization, and Artist Directories; and build greater familiarity with the Peak Radar brand throughout our community.
- **Social Media Content Creation:** The Outreach Coordinator will work in cooperation with other Cultural Office staff members to further Peak Radar's social media engagement on Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, YouTube, Pinterest, and LinkedIn.
- **General Program Support:** The Outreach Coordinator will support other staff members in the execution of new/existing Cultural Office programming such as Arts Month, Arts & Economic Prosperity 6, Curbside Culture, Creative Itineraries, etc.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Excellent writing, editing and speaking skills.
- Experience using social media to engage with a variety of stakeholders.
- Existing connections and/or involvement in the local creative community is a plus.
- Spanish language proficiency is a plus.

COMPETENCIES:

- Self-motivated, organized, professional, and adaptable.
- Interpersonal skills to positively work with a wide range of individuals and groups from culturally and geographically diverse communities within our region.
- Ability to meet deadlines, manage multiple tasks simultaneously, prioritize duties, and work independently as well as part of a team.
- Ability to think and work creatively.
- High level of comfort and competency with basic PC-based technology, including Microsoft Office applications like Word, Excel, Outlook, and PowerPoint.
- Familiarity with other software applications like WordPress, In-Design, and Constant Contact is a plus.

MINIMUM PERFORMANCE STANDARDS:

- All Cultural Office employees are responsible for promoting the mission of the organization, and maintaining a voice to advocate passionately for arts & culture--and for the Cultural Office specifically.
- All employees must follow branding and communications standards established for the organization.
- All employees are expected to maintain high degree of productivity, cooperation, attendance, and efficiency, whether working from the office, or remotely when necessary.
- Professional dress and manner are required to maintain a positive public image for the organization and a healthy office culture.
- Weekend and evening work duties may occasionally be necessary.

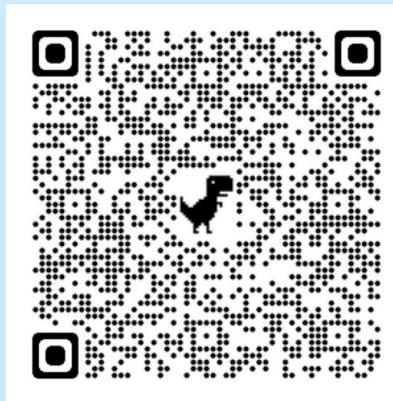

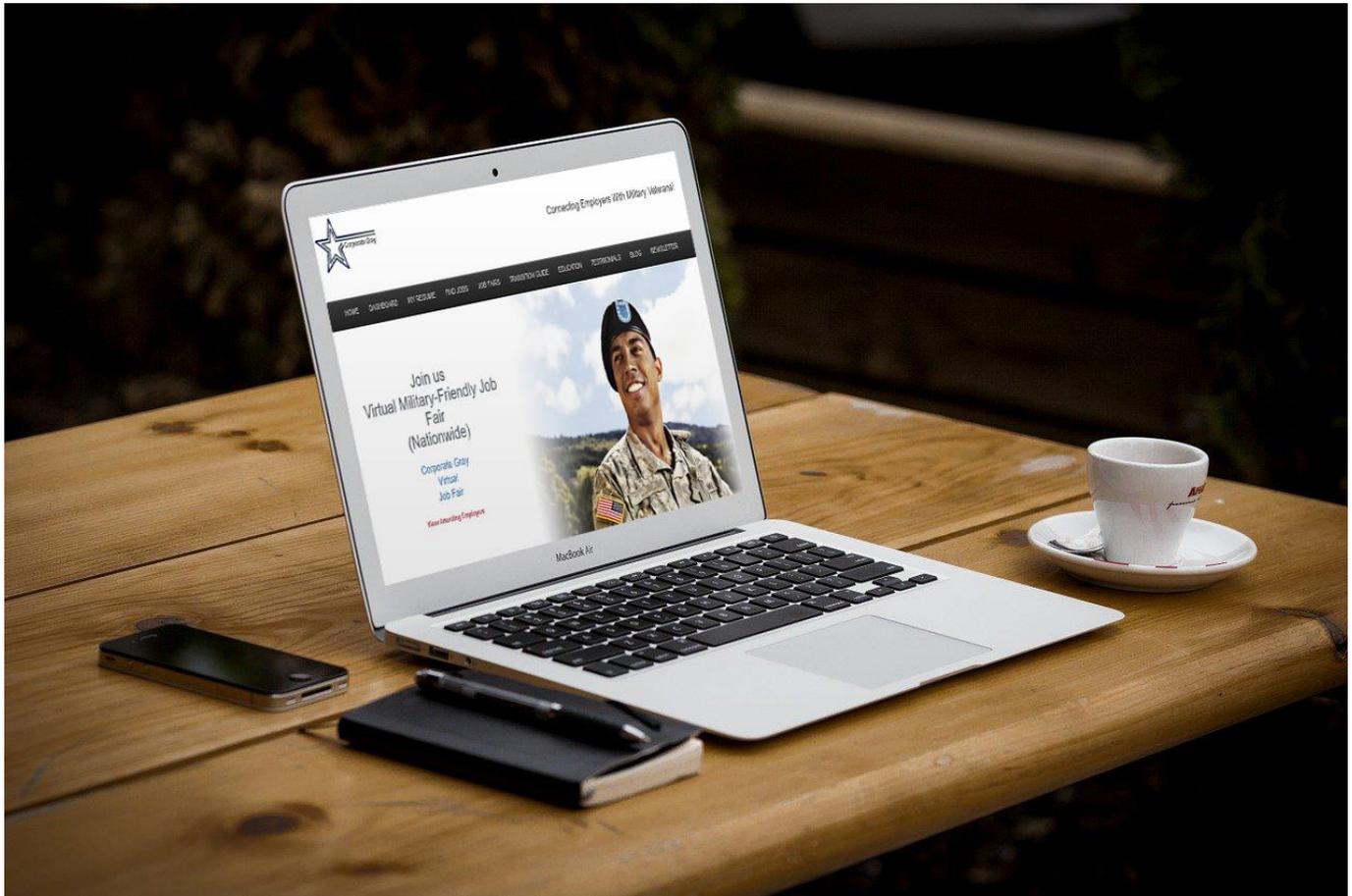

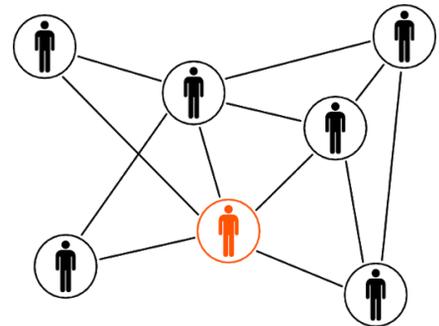
