Gate hours

Directorate of Emergency Services Physical Security and Access Control recently announced changes to Fort Carson Gate operating hours. Among the changes are that Gate 2, located off Highway 115 at O'Connell Boulevard, is closed indefinitely. Gate 4, located off B Street and Academy Blvd. hours have changed as outlined below.

- -- Gate 2: closed indefinitely
- --Gate 4: Open Monday-Friday from 5 a.m. to 9 p.m.; closed Monday-Friday from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., closed Saturday-Sunday, training holidays and federal holidays.
- --Temporary gate closure: Gates 6 and 19 will be closed Dec. 17 to Jan. 2. Drivers should plan to use alternate gates of entry/exit during this time. Normal hours of operation for gates 6 and 19 will resume Jan. 3 from 5 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday-Friday.
- --Over the next year patrons may see and experience several improvements to Fort Carson entry control points: improved scanners, improved entry control systems and improvements to traffic control and communication signs.

Military families face unique challenges. They may struggle with issues such as deployment-related stress, reintegration and pressures of managing parenting and finances while a loved one is deployed.

To support military families facing these or additional challenges, the MFLC program:

- » Provides short-term, non-medical counseling services to service members and their families at no cost
- » Provides psycho-education to help military service members and their families understand the impact of deployments, family reunions following deployments and other stresses related to the military life
- » Augments existing military support services
- » Offers flexible service delivery
- » Can provide services on or off of military installations
- » Can provide services to individuals, couples, families and groups

- The EAP assists employees, supervisors, and managers with issues related to productivity, morale, motivation, communication, conflict, and mediation.
- The EAP provides consultation services, prevention education and training, worksite interventions and assists with such issues as grief and loss, the drugfree workplace, workplace violence, and suicide.
- The EAP is the point-of-contact for Hospital's Impaired Health-Care Personnel Program and assists with screening, referral to treatment, and return to duty. The EAP provides continuing education and training to health care providers. The program offers CME, CNE, for continuing education.
