MILITARY AND FAMILY LIFE COUNSELOR PROGRAM

Military families face unique challenges. They may struggle with issues such as deployment-related stress, reintegration and pressures of managing parenting and finances while a loved one is deployed.

To support military families facing these or additional challenges, the MFLC program:

- » Provides short-term, non-medical counseling services to service members and their families at no cost
- » Provides psycho-education to help military service members and their families understand the impact of deployments, family reunions following deployments and other stresses related to the military life
- » Augments existing military support services
- » Offers flexible service delivery
- » Can provide services on or off of military installations
- » Can provide services to individuals, couples, families and groups

With the exception of child abuse, domestic abuse and duty to warn situations services are private and confidential.

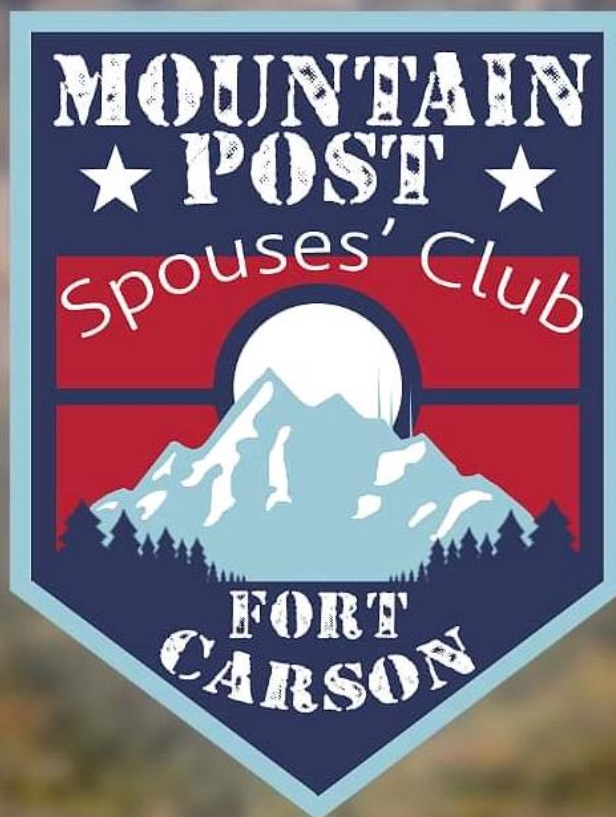

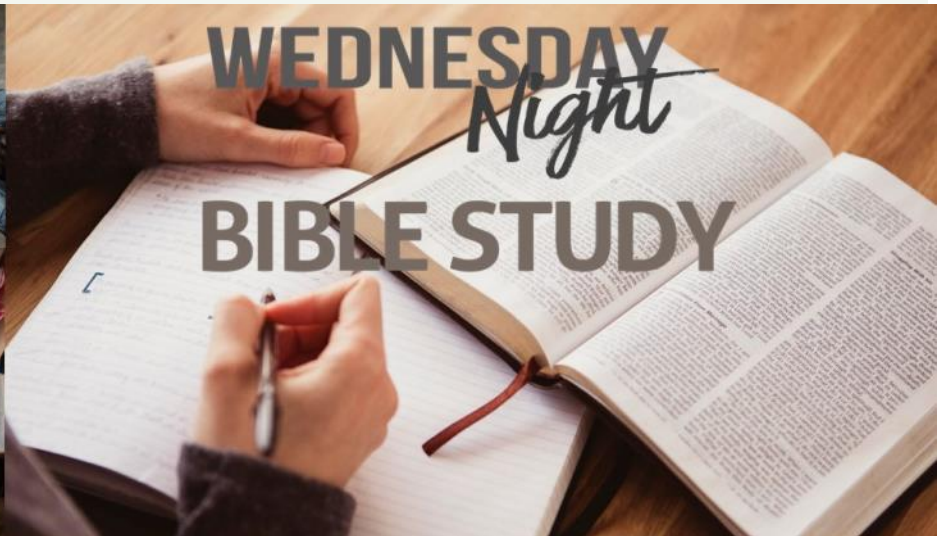

SUBJECT: Upgraded ArmyIgnitED Portal is Launching on 29 August!!

The upgraded ArmyIgnitED portal is launching on 29 August! When launched, Soldiers will be able to request tuition assistance for Fiscal Year 2023, courses starting after 1 October 2022 using the upgraded portal. The web address is changing from www.armyignited.com to www.armyignited.army.mil.

The Army is upgrading ArmyIgnitED to make it a reliable, smoothly functioning system, and a better experience for Soldiers. Our people deserve a reliable system that allows them to continue their education, and the Army is committed to getting this right.

Improvements to ArmyIgnitED will come in three phases, the first of which will help Soldiers to efficiently receive TA.

Phase One of the ArmyIgnitED system upgrade will be launched on Aug. 29, 2022. This initial upgrade will be focused on improving the TA process for Soldiers and includes the following capabilities:

- Soldiers can submit education goals and TA requests
- Educational Centers can create and update counseling notes
- Academic institutions can load courses, degree plans, grades, terms, submit invoices, verify tuition assistance requests, and submit refunds

Phase Two of the ArmyIgnitED system upgrade will be launched before the end of November 2022. Phase Two will provide additional capabilities, including:

- Soldiers can request credentialing assistance
- Soldiers can apply for Army Personnel Testing

Phase Three is expected in the third quarter of FY23 when the system will achieve its full operational capability.

1. What should Soldiers do now in preparation for the upgraded ArmyIgnitED?

Evaluated Degree Plan: Soldiers should contact their Academic Institutions and request an Evaluated Degree Plan. An evaluated degree plan shows the school's name, your name, degree pursuing, the total number of hours required to complete the degree, the total number of hours already completed with the school, the total number of transfer hours that were applied towards the degree program and the total number of hours that remain (need to be completed in order to graduate from the degree program).

2. What do Soldiers need to do once ArmyIgnitED is released?

Create an Account: Visit the ArmyIgnitED website, www.armyignited.army.mil, and click on "Login." This will register your CAC to the upgraded ArmyIgnitED. You will only need the URL and your CAC. (Login.gov will not be used to access the site.)

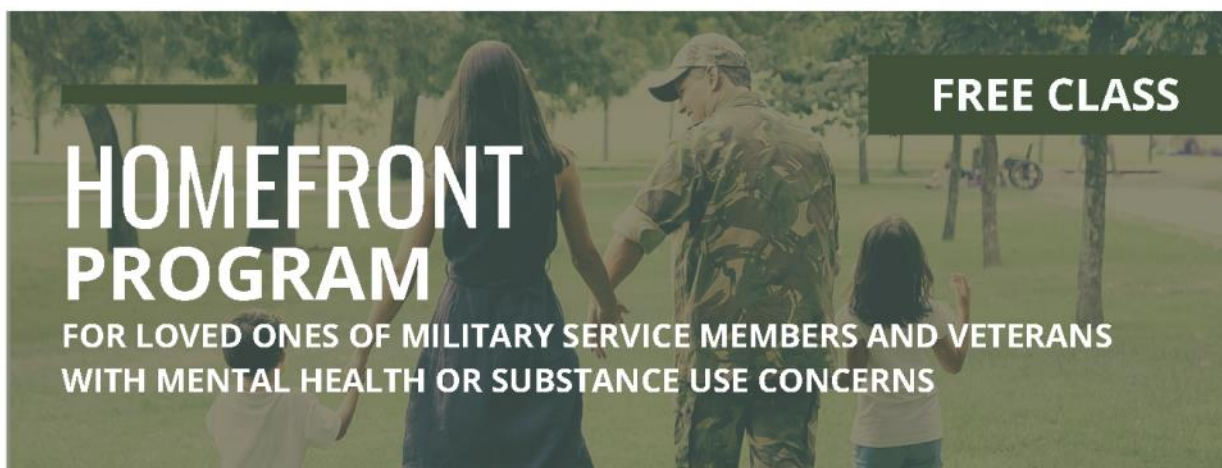

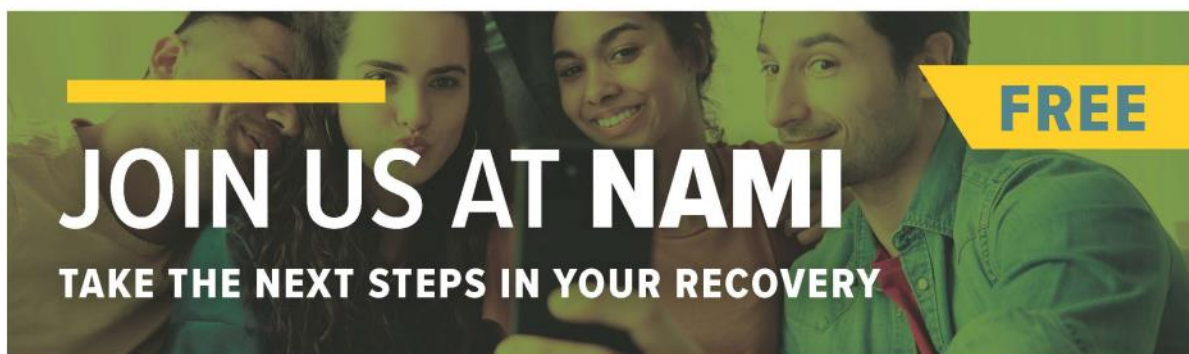

- » learn and refine coping skills and strategies;
- » find strength in sharing experiences;
- » embrace humor and celebrate victories.

PEER-TO-PEER

A class that examines mental health conditions and how to live better with them, meeting once a week for eight weeks. Peer-to-Peer students:

- » create personalized relapse prevention plans;
- » learn to advocate for better care from providers;
- » develop confidence for making decisions and reducing stress;
- » and pick up resources to help in recovery.

Classes typically scheduled twice annually.

IF YOU'RE READY TO HELP OTHERS...

When at stable places in their recovery, peers at NAMI find rewarding volunteer opportunities as Connection Support Group facilitators and/or Peer-to-Peer teachers. They also can train to be part of NAMI's In Our Own Voice program, in which they share their lived experiences and demystify mental health conditions for local people and groups. All training, and ongoing support, is provided.

VA mobile check-in for appointments check-in with your phone

Mobile check-in: Fast, easy, anywhere

Check in for your appointment right from your smartphone. Scan the QR code or text "check in" to the phone number provided on the mobile check-in poster in the check-in area.

No internet connection? Our staff are honored to check you in for your appointment and to answer any questions.

Check-in is the same whether you complete the process with mobile check-in or a staff member. Use mobile check-in on the day of your appointment to avoid potential lines at the check-in desk.

Pre-check-in from anywhere

After confirming your text appointment reminder, you may receive a link for pre-check-in.

Pre-check-in allows you to review your contact information, emergency contact and next-of-kin up to seven days before your appointment. Use pre-check-in for more privacy and to save time at the medical center.

Go to your provider's waiting area

After you've finished mobile check-in, you're all set. Have a seat and a VA staff member will come get you.



Need to update your insurance coverage, contact, or other information?

Check in with a staff member instead.

How to use mobile check-in



Scan the QR code or text "check in" to the phone number provided on the mobile check-in poster located in the check-in area.



Select the link sent to you.

Enter your last name and the last 4 digits of social security number.



Check in to your appointment.

You may be asked to review your contact information, emergency contact, and next-of-kin. If correct, press yes to confirm.

If you answer no to any of the above questions, you must check in with a staff member.

Check in for your appointment with the blue **"Check in now"** button.
