Description	<p>The Fort Carson Education Center offers the full range of Army Continuing Education Services (ACES), to include counseling, Basic Skills Education Program (BSEP), DANTES Education Testing, Army Personnel Testing and a computer lab/MLF. In addition, our five on-post schools offer several postsecondary programs. The Fort Carson Education Center provides information on a variety of education topics and programs such as Tuition Assistance, Credentialing Assistance, ArmyIgnitED website assistance, Montgomery and Post 9/11 GI Bill guidance.</p> <p>Tuition Assistance (TA): Mondays from 10-11 a.m. and Wednesdays from 2-3 p.m. Each Soldier is required to attend this briefing before speaking with a counselor.</p>

Members can print up to 5 pages a day. There is no time limit on computer use. - The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is available at FAFSA Application Federal Student Aid. College Classes	<p>There are five academic institutions that hold classes in the Fort Carson Education Center. Terms are 6-10 weeks in length.
