

### **ID Card Facility Closure**

ID Card facility located in building 1039 is closed through Dec. 18; it will resume normal operations, Monday-Friday 8-11:30 a.m. and 12:30-4 p.m., Dec. 21. Mountain Post Soldier Center location, building 1525, has three operational workstations to assist customers; Soldiers should seek ID card support through unit S1s. Dependent ID cards that expire after Jan. 1, 2020, will remain active through June 30, 2021.

### Gate 3 Express Hours Change

Gate 3 Express has temporarily changed its hours of operation. The temporary hours are 5 a.m. to 10 p.m. Monday-Friday and 8 a.m. to 10 p.m. Saturday-Sunday. Updates will be provided as they become available.

### **ACFT Alternate Event Training**

Effective Dec. 11, Directorate of Family and Morale, Welfare and Recreation will implement procedures for scheduling and conducting Army combat fitness test (ACFT) alternate event testing and training at Ivy Fitness Center. Ivy Fitness Center will have a small number of spin bikes and rowers available for use only by Soldiers on profile for ACFT testing/training purposes. Soldiers on profile will need to check in with fitness center management about using these limited pieces of equipment. COVID-19 mitigations of 12-foot spacing and masks will be required during exercise for both training and testing sessions.

### Procedures:

- --All alternate events will take place at Ivy Fitness Center, building 1925 on the center basketball court.
- --Alternate events must be scheduled a minimum of 48 hours prior to conducting the event.
- --Alternate events must be scheduled with the following points of contact: Sean Gillotte, program manager, Ivy Fitness Center, 526-2151 or <a href="mailto:sean.m.gillotte.naf@mail.mil">sean.m.gillotte.naf@mail.mil</a>. In the event Sean Gillotte is not available, contact Tim Agan, Fitness Program specialist, Ivy Fitness Center, 524-3773 or <a href="mailto:timothy.j.agan3.naf@mail.mil">timothy.j.agan3.naf@mail.mil</a> --Requesting POC must provide the following information: Event POC name, event POC phone number, event POC email address, requested event date and time, equipment requesting to be used (spin bike or rower), number of event participants. Preferred method of request is through email; reservation confirmation will be emailed to the requesting POC.
- --Requesting POC will check in at Ivy Fitness Center front desk on their reserved date and time. Reserved time blocks will be one hour total. Requesting POC is responsible for conducting the alternate event. Fitness Program Specialist Tim Agan will be available for assistance. Requesting POC is responsible for ensuring all participants and evaluators follow all fitness center SOPs and all current COVID-19 mitigation protocols. Requesting POC will ensure all equipment is cleaned and disinfected and put back in storage location and will inform front desk staff upon completion of event and clean up procedures.

### Gate Closures and Hours

Gates 2, 6, and 19 will be closed Dec 24-25 for Christmas Eve and Christmas; Jan. 1 for New Year's Day; and Jan. 15 for Martin Luther King Jr.'s Birthday. Normal hours of operation for gates 2, 6 and 19 are 5 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday-Friday.

### **Commissary Holiday Hours**

The Fort Carson Commissary holiday hours for Dec. 24, Christmas Eve, will be 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. The commissary is closed Dec. 25 and Jan. 1.

### **Automatic Shuttle Service Update**

During the holiday leave period, the Pilot Project, Mountain Express Automatic Shuttle, will not run Dec. 21-31. Shuttle operations will begin again Jan. 4 from 4-8 p.m. During these next few weeks, people may see the shuttle on the route performing tests and diagnostics. However, it will not be accepting passengers until it returns to service in January.

### **Extended Downrange Passes**

Fort Carson Range Operations will have new passes for calendar year 2021. Any individual who may be in possession of a current extended pass, is hereby notified that those passes issued in 2020 or prior will no longer be valid. If you have an extended pass, bring your current pass to the Range Operations Safety Office to have the pass exchanged for a new one. Individuals who display the old pass after Jan. 1 will have the pass confiscated and must report to the Range Safety Office to get a new one. If you have any questions, contact the Range Safety Office at 526-6330.

### Pipe Freeze Warning

With winter weather here, temperatures can drop below freezing suddenly. Significant facility damage is possible if appropriate actions are not taken. Facility managers, building occupants and unit leadership are asked to ensure the following:

- --Ensure all windows and exterior doors are closed.
- --Keep all heating systems on even in unoccupied buildings (do not turn off any units). Set any self-adjustable thermostats to at least 55 degrees (barracks set to 60 degrees).
- --Building occupants can call 526-5345, the Directorate of public Works (DPW) operations and maintenance contractor 24/7 service order desk, if their buildings are not heating properly.
- --If there are any busted or leaking pipes noticed, call in a service order immediately to the DPW operations and maintenance contractor at 526-5345.



- State What You Do & How You Do It
- Emphasize 1-3 Things About Yourself & Your Ambition
- Answer the Question--Why You?
- Write Your Pitch, Edit What You Write; Record It

### HOW TO DELIVER YOUR ELEVATOR PITCH

- Make Sure it Sounds Natural & Feels Natural to You
- Keep It Short & Sweet, No longer Than 30 Seconds
- Make Eye Contact & Be Confident...Even Virtually
- Don't Talk Too Fast

Elevator Pitches are useful any time you meet someone new-at a job fair, an interview, a spouse group, a business meeting. Remember to keep your audience in mind and tailor your pitch accordingly. Then, practice...a lot.







### **ARE YOU ABOUT TO PCS?**

AER can help Active Duty Soldiers, Active Guard and Reserve Soldiers\*, and their Families, with zero-interest loans, grants, or a combination of both.

\*Title 10 orders for at least 31 consecutive days. Exceptions may apply. Talk to your nearest Military Aid Office.

### **AER CAN HELP**

AER can help with expenses **before, during, and after a PCS,** such as auto repair, rent deposit, temporary lodging, appliance repair, child care assistance, spouse relicensing, and more.



Assistance for pet-boarding may be offered as an exception.

Talk to your nearest AER officer to learn more.



### **HOW TO APPLY**

3 ways to receive assistance from AER:

### **DETAILS ABOUT PET BOARDING**

- AER may provide assistance for pet boarding fees, as an exception, for Soldiers affected by the COVID-19 pre & post PCS 14-day quarantine (Restriction of Movement)
- Pet boarding assistance may be provided for up to 15 days pre and post PCS (30 days total)
- Requests for more than 30 days of pet boarding will be forwarded to HQ AER for consideration
- Soldiers must provide an estimate of the pet boarding costs
- Assistance may be provided as a zero-interest loan, grant, or combination of both

### Prenatal Mom to Child Age 3:

For children under 3, CPCD's Early Head Start programs serves prenatal moms, infants and toddlers living in low income situations, experiencing developmental concerns or having identified special needs. Due to the long wait lists of this program, families must qualify with these factors.

### My child is between 3-5:

CPCD operates both Head Start and the Colorado Preschool Program for 3 to 5 year-olds. With these two programs eligibility needs vary. We encourage families at 300% of poverty and below to apply. Family situations and development concerns will also be factors in the placement process.


