





School Support Services (SSS) provides Army Families and school-aged youth with educational opportunities, resources and information necessary to achieve academic success. A branch of Child and Youth Services (CYS), SSS is home to the School Liaison Office, where School Liaison Officers (SLOs) help deliver the best educational resources and information for your children. We specialize in education transitions, making sure incoming and exiting Families have information about local schools, graduation requirements, after-school programs, youth sponsorship, and homeschooling resources.

Education

Our office is ready to answer your questions, offer support and resources, and connect you with schools you may want to learn more about. <u>Advance School Enrollment</u> is available for Inbound Active-Duty Military Member Dependents.

School Options

- Public school zoned for your neighborhood
- Public school out of your zone/district utilizing Open Enrollment
- Public charter school
- Homeschool
- Private school

Important Information

- Colorado is unique because it is an <u>Open Enrollment</u> state. The Public Schools of Choice law (C.R.S. 22-36-101) allows resident pupils to enroll at schools in Colorado districts for which they are not zoned.
- Utilizing Open Enrollment or Charter schools are tuition-free.
- If you choose a public school out of your zone/district, you must apply for acceptance and there are enrollment windows. Some districts operate on a first-come, first-served system based on space available. Other school districts operate on a lottery system based on space available as well.
- If you choose a public school out of your zone/district, you are responsible for transporting your child (ren) to and from school. Please note that Cheyenne Mountain School District 12 in Colorado Springs provides **NO transportation.**






The program will run full time (M-F, 0645-1615) from 12 January 2026 to 22 July 2026. All classes must be attended; no partial credit will be given.


















Military & Family Life Counselor (MFLC) services have expanded to provide continuity of care to our community by offering **free confidential counseling** to service members and immediate Family members.
