



The Warrior Adventure Quest (WAQ) is a reintegration program to help Soldiers respond to stress and excitement following a major training or deployment. Promoting positive adrenaline responses, improving morale and communication, and developing trust and teamwork through adventure-based activities.

This program is fully funded by the Department of the Army and MWR.

Eligibility

- Conducted at a platoon level
- Must be executed within the first 120 days of returning from a major training or deployment
- Must be conducted during a duty day
- Mandatory completion of post activity survey
- If a unit has not been on a WAQ trip within two years. Each platoon is allowed one WAQ program per RESET cycle
