Requirements	<p>To take part in BOSS activities or events or to be a part of their Council, Servicemembers need to be either:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - a single Soldier - a single Soldier parent or - an unaccompanied Soldier <p>*other Military branches are able to take part in BOSS as long as they are stationed at Fort Carson.</p> <p>There is no rank restriction as long as they meet the listed criteria.</p>
